Only limited information is available for these years, and before 1850 only the names of heads of households were recorded together with statistical information relating to the other members of the household or family.

The standard of literacy in many parts of America at the time was variable at best, with many names being misspelled on the returns. Variants thought to be misspellings of Debenham have been included as shown.

This was the first census in which the names of all members of each household were recorded, though the relationship of each person to the head of household was not shown until the 1880 census.

The 1870 Census (1 June 1870)

The 1870 census was the first in which the place of birth of each parent was recorded, though at this time it was only a distinction between birth within the United States and birth elsewhere. The question asked was whether the parent concerned was of foreign birth, and only 'Yes' and 'No' answers are recorded. The remaining information is of the same kind as in 1860.
